I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your application for appointment as a justice of the peace for the Toronto Region.

A panel of Committee members will review, evaluate and classify your application. Your classification will then be reported to the Attorney General. This classification will be for the period of June 1, 2010 to May 31, 2012. As is the policy with similar committees of this kind, your classification is not disclosed to you.

You may or may not be interviewed as part of the classification process. Only those applicants selected for an interview will be contacted. Please note that the Committee receives a significant number of applications from the seven regions of the province, all of which are thoroughly evaluated. As a result, a considerable amount of time may elapse between the submission of an application and the request by the Committee for an applicant to attend an interview.

Should you wish to be considered for a justice of the peace appointment beyond May 31, 2012, you may re-apply during the Committee's advertising period in September 2011. The advertisement will be posted on the Committee's website at www.ontariocourts.on.ca/jpaac/en.
